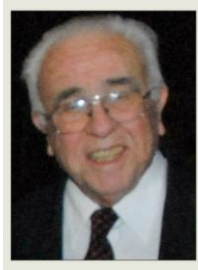


Dr. Jose Quiroga Honored for His Efforts on Behalf of Torture Survivors



The Program for Torture Victims is extremely proud to announce that our co-founder and medical director, Dr. Jose Quiroga, has accepted the prestigious Inge Genefke Award for 2012. The award will be shared with Jim Jaranson, a peer of Dr. Quiroga's.

The Inge Genefke Award is given every other year by the Anti-Torture Support Foundation (ATSF) to honor individuals who have done outstanding work in the global fight against torture. This award cannot be applied for -- recipients are chosen by the board of ATSF, a prominent human rights organization based in Denmark and established by the award's namesake, Dr. Inge Genefke, a pioneer in the field of torture treatment. The official award ceremony will take place this November at the board meeting of the International Rehabilitation Council for Torture Victims.
